The Sixth International Symposium on Tonal Aspects of Languages will be held in Berlin, Germany,

Monday, June 18 till Wednesday, June 20, 2018. TAL 2018 will be organized at Beuth University Berlin

conveniently located in the city center close to all major attractions. TAL 2018 is timed after Speech Prosody 2018 in Poznań, Poland, June 13-16, only a three-hour train ride away. TAL 2018 is supported by the International Speech Communication Association and the ISCA SProSIG.

The symposium will continue the tradition of the previous five symposia, aiming to present state-ofthe-art research on the typological, phonetic, phonological, psycholinguistic, acquisitional, and technological aspects of tonal contrasts.
